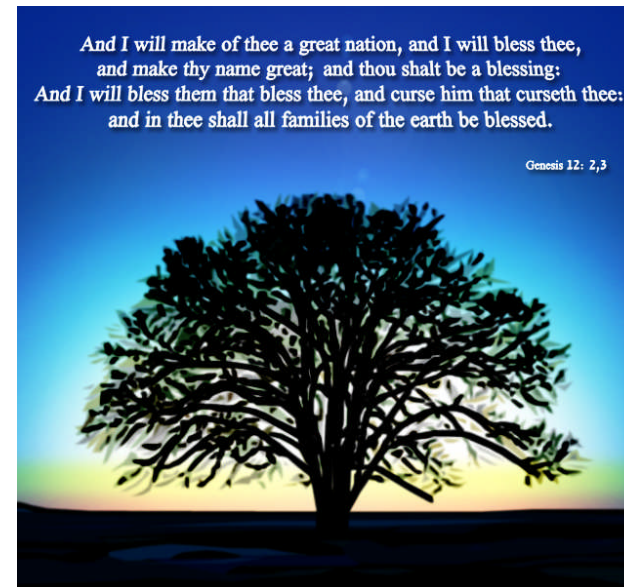

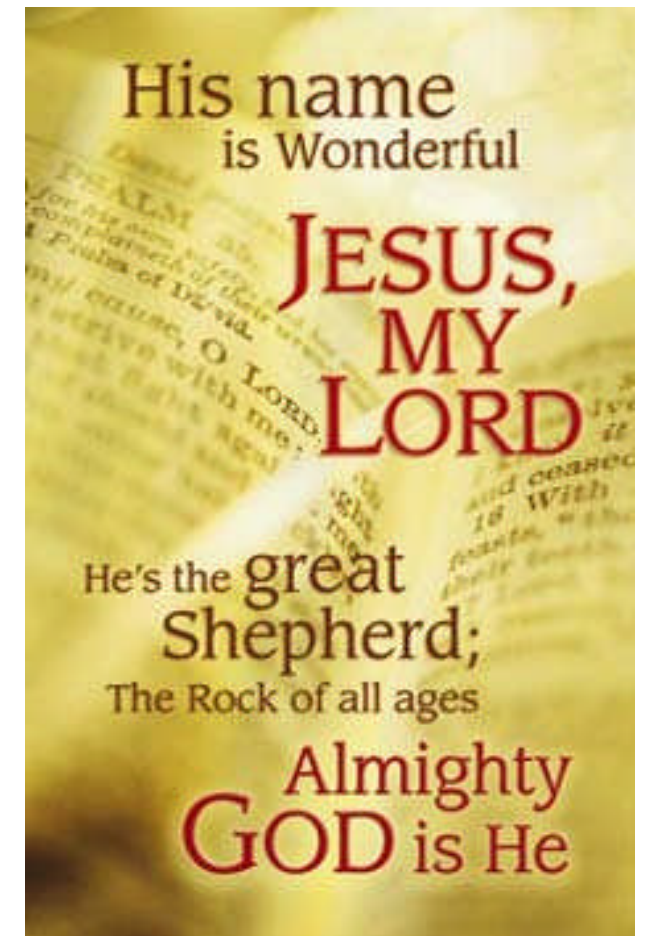

Ministry Health Kits

- 1 Toothpaste ((6 oz.)
- 1 Washcloth
- 1 Comb

Items should be placed in a 2-gallon zip lock type bag. Kits are due Monday, April 2nd. Place your kits in the designated box downstairs outside church office.
